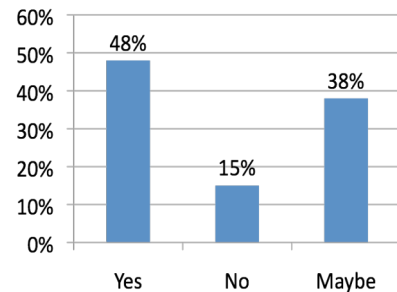

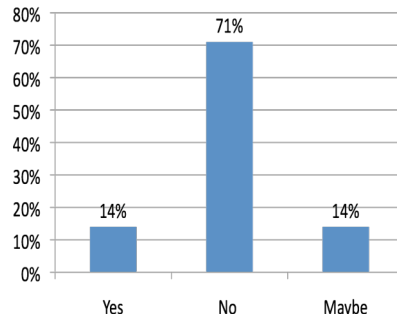
Do you believe that increased observation and feedback could help you become a better teacher?

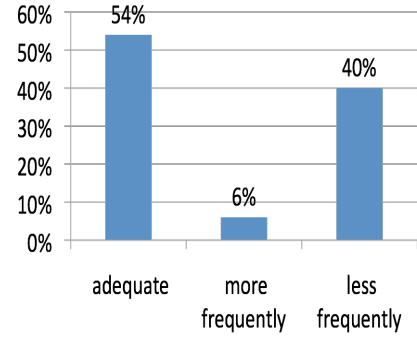
Does the current evaluation system support and improve your teaching practice?

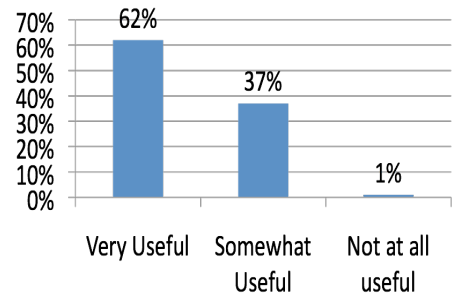

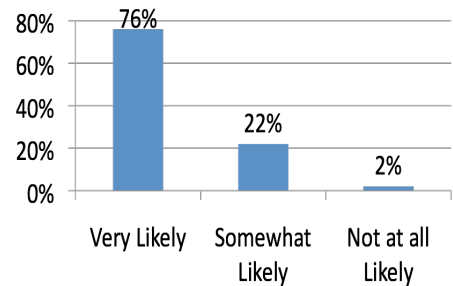
How useful was the information presented tonight?
